The 1916 St Marys company motto read "that which is worth doing at all, is worth doing well". The history of our company since 1908 has been "quality and service" producing finished goods of the highest grade possible.

Our current senior staff and I were taught by employees who started at this Hespeler factory as early as 1933. They enjoyed the opportunity to work with those employees who transferred from St Marys, Ontario where baseball bat production started in 1908. I have many fond memories of Tom Marquis

who transferred as the Plant Engineer running steam power for the plant to power machinery as both plants were running before electricity came to our areas.

My daughter, Rachel, joined as Vice President in 1999 and her daughter, Joscelyne, started in 2018 as Office Manager. Our entire history has been built by generations of families and extended families who chose to work at the factory, putting great effort and skill into making the highest quality baseball bats.

Our KR3 Sales Manager, Stan, started working in the sporting goods industry in 1988. Our production is currently supervised by Steve, who started in this plant in 1982. Our head lathe turner, Davy, started in 1976.

Millions of bats have been made under the brands St Marys, Cooper and KR3, including over 300,000 for professional players.

- Historically, all wooden bats were made for over 100 years by splitting logs and turning these splits into round billets. Only with the startup of Maple was sawn lumber introduced to save money.


Pro Grade - Ink Dot Certified

- All our Maple and Birch bats pass the Ink Dot test ensuring that the wood cells are correctly aligned which dramatically reduces breakage.
- The "Ink Dot Certified" label is located on the face grain of our Canadian Rock Maple and Hi-Impact Birch models (Ash does not require an ink dot test). This is accurately measured with a Pro supplied test gauge to ensure the face grain wood cells are straight.
- Note: a bat can be Ink Dot Tested and still fail. Testing alone does not mean it is a better
 bat. KR3 offers Ink Dot Certified bats meaning that they are Ink Dot passed. We are
 proud to offer our players straighter grain and stronger bats to help them perform better
 at the plate.

BONING

- Bone rubbing goes back to Ty Cobb, who would fasten his bat in the clubhouse vise and rub them for hours with a large bone hollowed out from the thigh of a steer.
- Starting in our plant in 1933 and passed down from **generation to generation**, the procedure has been updated and finely tuned by KR3.
- All of our wood bats are boned at the factory, making the hitting surface **7% to 10% harder**. This allows the hitter to drive the ball much farther.

- KR3 is Canada's oldest bat manufacturer with **over 110 years** of bat making experience. Our manufacturing roots go back to March 30th 1908 in St. Marys, Ontario, when Solen Doolittle started manufacturing baseball bats.

- 1958—50 year anniversary running models: Mantle, Williams, Snider and Musial
- 1972—Cooper buys operation now running out of Hespeler. Changes label to Cooper
- Jack Cooper builds on his success with dedication to high performance, quality products and great service
- 1989—30% of Major League players using Cooper and at 8500/year,
 #2 behind Louisville
- 1996—Cooper line discontinued at plant
- 1999—Hespeler Plant Manager since 1976 starts KR3 and 3rd generation label of "Canadian Bat Manufacturing" continues
- 2003—Launch Maple Magnum wood composite with 90 day warranty, BBCOR approved
- **2004**—Launch **Hickory Magnum** wood composite with 6 month warranty, BBCOR approved
